WHAT IS BEULAH BOG?

Beulah Bog State Natural Area is a 78-acre property owned by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources in East Troy, Wisconsin. It is protected because of the presence of vegetation normally found in Northern Wisconsin – undisturbed ecologically rich bogs and tamarack forests.

Kettle Moraine Land Trust adopted Beulah Bog in 2009; the adoption of a state natural area provides volunteer and financial resources to restore and maintain the oak savanna community.

Since its adoption, Land Trust board members and volunteers have donated funding as well as hundreds of hours to its upkeep. In 2010 the Land Trust was recognized for its efforts by the Natural Resources Foundation.

To preserve the natural heritage of the southern Kettle Moraine lakes area and nearby lands through partnerships in land conservancy and resource management.


In a unique partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, in 2009 we adopted the Beulah Bog State Natural Area.

From the intersection of County Roads J and E proceed east on County Rd. J about 0.5 miles to Stringers Bridge Road, then south on Stringers Bridge 0.8 mile to the parking area on the east side of the road.
